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
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
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
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






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


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



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


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My name is Zainab, but you can find my kawaii doodles on the internet under the handle Pic Candle. I recently quit my day job to doodle full time, because I love drawing so much. Crazy, right?!

I approach my doodles randomly without planning or thinking about the end results. I find this process to be very exciting because you never know what's going to happen.

It's a surprise! I usually start with a doodle character or object that comes to mind and then keep drawing more characters and decorations, one by one, to fill up the page (see my Search-&-Find Puzzles starting on page 129). While doodling, I focus only on the character or object that I'm drawing, not the big picture.

Regarding coming up with characters, they're mainly inspired by real-life objects and simple shapes (such as a sphere, cube, cylinder, pyramid, and cone) that I have modified or combined. I also like creating make-believe characters (see my doodle monsters throughout this book).

I hope this book inspires you to develop a love for doodling and creating kawaii characters. So grab your passport, because the *Kawaii Doodle Cuties* grand tour is about to begin!

#### What Is Kawaii?

You might have heard the word. You have probably seen the hashtag. You definitely know the style. But what, exactly, does kawaii mean?

Kawaii is a Japanese concept or idea, dating back to the 1970s, that translates closely to "cuteness" in English. In Japan, the usage of the word is quite broad and can be used to describe anything cute, from clothing and accessories to handwriting and art. So if you are a fan of emoji art or the style of beloved characters like Hello Kitty, Pokémon, or Pusheen the Cat, then you already know and love the kawaii style of art!

While there are many interpretations as to what constitutes the "kawaii" art aesthetic, most people can agree that kawaii art is usually composed of very simple black outlines, pastel colors, and characters or objects with a rounded, youthful appearance. Facial expressions in kawaii art are minimal and characters are frequently drawn with oversized heads and smaller bodies.

In this book, I'll show you how to draw kawaii-inspired art using things from around the world, like food, nature, architecture, and more. The great thing about kawaii culture is that it's not limited to anything, so once you start practicing, you can turn even the most common thing into something kawaii!

#### How to Use This Book

Kawaii Doodle Cuties includes seven sections (Adorable Food, Precious Nature & Natural Wonders, Enchanting Architecture & Monuments, Lovable Animals & Birds, Charming Transportation, Fetching Fashion, and Everyday Cute) with more than 65 characters for you to learn how to draw.

Each character is illustrated with simple step-by-step instructions to get you started doodling. Each chapter also includes Get Inspired pages, showing you even more doodle ideas.

At the back of the book is a section called Fun Time! with Search-&-Find Puzzles that you can also color.

#### Tools

You don't need to invest in many tools to get started doodling kawaii. You can use pen and paper, or you can draw digitally, or you can start with pen and paper and then scan your art in case you want to color it digitally. It's up to you!

#### **BLACK PENS**

The pens I use most are fineliner pens as they come in various tip sizes. I prefer to work with 3 tip sizes for varying line widths, though your end results can also be

achieved using only one pen. Here are the tip sizes I use:

- thin tip (for tiny details, patterns, and shadows)
- medium-size tip (for main outlining)
- thick tip (for thicker outlining outside of the main outlines—this is to make characters stand out and also for filling in large areas with black)

#### WHITE PENS

I use these for corrections and adding highlights.


#### **PAPER**

I'm not too picky when it comes to the paper I use for doodling. Basic sketchbooks and printer paper work just fine, but if you want to use something more professional, that's a personal preference.

#### MECHANICAL PENCILS

Since ink is permanent, sketching with pencil before inking is helpful when drawing complex characters. Mechanical pencils are great for drawing lines and the option of varying lead thicknesses is useful.





#### **FRASFR**

A good eraser is always needed for fixing those sketching mistakes. And there are always mistakes!

#### **RULER**

Depending on how precise you want to be with your lines and such, it can't hurt to have a ruler on hand.

#### MARKERS AND/ OR WATERCOLORS (OPTIONAL)

I like using 1 or 2 colors and adding them only in some areas of my doodles, leaving other areas blank. This "semi-coloring" method works for me because it takes less time to do, and it's also easy and fun. The chances of ruining my doodles are also reduced with semi-coloring. If you want to color your doodles, semi-coloring is a good practice and less intimidating for beginners.


#### PHOTOSHOP (OPTIONAL)

When I doodle using pen and ink and then scan the image, I use Photoshop to clean it and prepare a print-ready file. Sometimes, I also like to add colors to hand-drawn doodles digitally with Photoshop. Mixing the traditional and digital processes to create final artwork is also fun!

#### Tips & Tricks


Being a full-time doodle artist, I want to share the tips and tricks I have learned over time for creating kawaii characters.

- Sketch your characters with a mechanical pencil before inking them, especially more complex characters.
- When drawing square, rectangular, and pointy shapes, rounding corners and points always adds a cuter element to the character.
- Adding a simple face is always recommended, but if you don't have room, no worries. Faceless characters can also be cute!







 But if you prefer giving your characters a face, drawing their bodies or faces wider will give you more room to do this.




 Speaking of faces, go ahead and play around with the position of the face. You don't have to place the face in the center every time, or ever!



 Varying the distance between a character's eyes and mouth can really change the appearance of a facial expression.



 Drawing a nose, along with eyes and a mouth, can really add "character" to your characters.



- Once you have drawn your characters, feel free to adorn them with decorations (hearts, stars, speech bubbles, etc.).

- Most importantly, there are no right or wrong ways to doodle kawaii characters.
   Just experiment and try to come up with your own unique style with the help of this book!


### Macaron














- 1. Draw a semicircle.
- 2. Close the semicircle with a slightly curved line, with rounded edges extending past the sides.
- Draw short, curved lines from the sides of the macaron top, for the filling.



 Draw the bottom of the macaron in the style of the top, but don't make it as deep and rounded.




 With a fine point pen, draw dots and dashes on the top and bottom of the cookie to give it some texture.




## Kiwifruit









1. Draw a circle.




2. Draw a curved line off the right half of the circle, like a crescent moon.




3. Draw a partial oval off the left side of the kiwifruit half.



4. With a fine point pen, draw a series of lines of varying lengths in a circle, for the fruit's center.




5. Now place some seeds throughout those lines.





6. Add some dots and dashes to both kiwifruits for texture. Draw a cute face, of course!


#### Pizza












- 1. Draw an incomplete circle.
- Complete the circle by drawing an inverted triangle, kind of like Pac-Man. Now draw a triangle of a similar size for the pizza slice.
- 3. Draw a second, slightly wavy line inside the first outline for the crust. Don't forget to add crust to the pizza slice!








- 4. Draw a cute face, of course!
- 5. With a fine point pen, add your favorite toppings. I drew tomato slices, basil leaves, olives, and more! Add some dots along the crust and on the pizza for a little texture.


## Yogurt













- 1. Draw an incomplete oval.
- 2. Draw a curved line from the bottom of the incomplete oval.
- Draw a deeper curved line off this one to complete the base of the bowl.
- 4. Draw a wavy line in the bowl for the yogurt. Complete the top oval by adding a spoon handle. Don't forget to add some lines where the spoon enters the yogurt!







With a fine point pen, add seeds to the strawberries, along with some granola in the yogurt.




Draw a few vertical lines on the base of the bowl, leaving space for a cute face. Don't forget to draw that!


## Crêpe









 Draw a deep V shape, with a rounded point and curved lines at the top. Draw another curving line for a fold in the crêpe.



2. Draw a second curved line to complete the fold.



3. Fill the crêpe with your favorite fillings. I like custard, strawberries, and whipped cream! I added seeds to the strawberries and dots to the custard for texture with a fine point pen.



4. Finish by adding some dots to the crêpe for texture and drawing a cute face, of course!

## Chocolates







- 1. Draw an L shape at an angle.
- 2. Draw a short, slanted line off each of the 3 edges. Connect these lines, making rounded corners.



3. Begin building your box of 6 chocolates, starting with placement in the near corner and moving up and to the left. You can follow my chocolate styles or come up with your own!




4. Keep adding those chocolates! Cubes, spheres, hearts, swirls . . .



Once you have your 6 chocolates placed, draw lines on the left side and back of the box to complete it.



6. Draw a cute face, of course!




7. With a fine point pen, add details and decorate your chocolates and the box. Yum!


## Pretzel









1. With a pencil, draw 2 interlocking shapes as guidelines for the pretzel.




2. Continuing with the pencil and starting at the bottom center, draw a fat pretzel shape around the guidelines. You should be able to do this in one continuous line, but it might take a few tries!



3. To create the pretzel twist, draw a line from point A to point B.




 Erase any unnecessary pencil lines so your pretzel is clean like my drawing. Use a pen to ink the remaining lines.




Draw a cute face, of course! With a fine point pen, draw small circles for salt.













- Draw a cube shape, with rounded corners, followed by 3 more of these shapes, all connecting.
- 2. Add a stick with a rounded point.
- Draw 2 more rows of skewers behind the first one. These only need to show the top halves except for the ones sticking out on the ends.








5. Add some sauce to the platter.



 Draw cute faces, of course! With a fine point pen, add some small ovals and dots to give the satay texture. Also add some sauce on top of one piece of meat.



7. Don't forget to serve it with sauce, lime, cucumber segments, and fresh herbs!

## Meatballs









- Draw 2 short lines that curve out and then in again. Connect these lines to make the bowl.
- On the right side of the bowl, draw a lumpy semicircle for a meatball. Top it with a leaf.
- Add another meatball to the left side of the bowl that touches the first meatball. Draw the top of a third meatball behind the first two.






- 4. With a fine point pen, give the meatballs texture with some dots and small geometric shapes.
- 5. Add a napkin underneath the bowl, along with a bowl of sauce (with a spoon) and some berries as garnish.



6. Draw cute faces, of course!

## Tamales





- 1. Draw 2 connected semicircles with tiny scalloped edges.
- Draw 3 vertical lines from the edges of the semicircles, leaving a small opening in the line on the right.
- Complete the bottoms of the corn husks. Add bows and/or ties around the corn husks.
- Add some delicious filling to the husks, drawing circles and giving the one on the left a little more detail.



5. Draw cute faces, of course!



 With a fine point pen, add dots and small circles to the filling and draw vertical lines on the husks for texture.




## Dumplings




1. Draw a line with puckers.



Draw curved lines off this line as if drawing a fat, incomplete pear. On the right side, draw a shape to replicate a bite taken out of the dumpling.




3. Give more detail to the "bite" with another bite shape inside. With a fine point pen, add dots for texture.




4. Draw a second dumpling off the first one.










5. Draw cute (or sad) faces, of course!

6. With a fine point pen, add a couple dots to the top of each dumpling for texture. Don't forget the condiments! I drew a bowl of sauce, garnished with a garlic head and cloves.



- 7. Close up the dumpling on the right and add a dashed, curved line coming off the bottom of each one.
- 8. Finish by placing your dumplings and condiments on a napkin.

## Halo-Halo



 Draw a U shape that is flatter than normal on the bottom, making rounded corners.



2. Add a line at the top and bottom of this shape to define the glass shape. Give curved ends to the top edges of the U shape.



 Add a scoop of *ube* (purple yam) ice cream, topped with *pinipig* (flattened roasted rice).



4. Add the next layer of gelatin cubes and tropical fruits, such as lychee, mango, kiwi . . . whatever you want! (Note: When adding the layers to the glass here and in the next steps, leave some room on each side and the bottom to give the glass some heft.)



5. The next layer is the shaved ice and evaporated milk.







6. Add the final layer of sweetened kidney beans and chickpeas.



7. Draw a spoon handle and a fun drink umbrella.





8. Why not add some cookie wafers?



Add some bubbles to the middle layer and some texture to the ice cream. And draw cute faces, of course!


## Ramen






1. Draw an oval.

2. Lay chopsticks (page 116) on top of the oval.




3. Draw a curved line to complete the bowl shape.




4. Add the toppings at the near side of the bowl. I drew egg halves, meat pieces, and some greens. With a fine point pen, draw dots and dashes to give the meat texture.











5. Continuing with the fine point pen, draw some swirling lines for the noodles.

6. Add more toppings to the far side of the bowl. I drew bamboo shoots, mushroom tops, and some seasoning. With a fine point pen, draw groups of dots to give the bamboo shoots and mushrooms texture.





7. Fill in any remaining spaces in the bowl with swirling lines of noodles drawn with a fine point pen.





1. Draw a wide mountain shape, leaving the bottom open. Add a fluffy cloud on the right side.



2. Close up the mountain with a straight line that has pointy yet rounded edges.



3. Add a snowcap to the mountain, kind of like dripping paint.




4. Add a couple more clouds and some ovals of snow farther down the mountain.



5. Draw a cute face, of course!








- 1. Draw a heart shape, leaving its bottom open.
- 2. Draw 2 more connecting heart shapes, leaving an opening at the bottom for the stem.



3. Add a stem with a rounded point.



4. Draw a cute face, of course!






- 1. Draw an egg shape.
- 2. Draw a curved line off each side of the egg shape for petals.
- 3. Add 2 small arcs at the top for more petals.



4. Draw a stem, leaving it open at the bottom.



5. Add long leaves at the base of the stem.





 Decorate your tulip with some doodle elements. I drew a heart and chubby stars.


# Sunflower











- 1. Draw a circle, giving the line a little texture.
- Draw a shape, like a feather, off the top of the circle.
- Continue drawing these featherlike shapes around the circle, overlapping one another a bit.
- Make a second row of petals by drawing in 1 or 2 upside-down V shapes between the first layer of petals.



5. Draw a stem and a couple of leaves.



 With a fine point pen, draw dots and dashes on the circle and first layer of petals to give the sunflower some texture.



# Maple Leaf








- 1. Using a pencil, draw a line at an angle.
- Continuing with the pencil, draw a large V shape and then a smaller upside-down V shape a little past halfway down the angled line. These are your guidelines.



Following the points of your guidelines, draw the leaf shape around them with a pen.



4. Erase the pencil guidelines and add a stem.




5. Draw a cute face, of course!

## Orchid











- Draw a fat horseshoe shape with a circle and lines closing off the top.
- 2. Draw a large, rounded petal off the right side of the orchid's center.
- Draw a second petal off the left side, making sure the first petal slightly overlaps it.







- Add 3 more incomplete petals behind the original petals: 1 peeking out the top and 2 at the bottom.
- 5. Add a stem that is open at the bottom and draw a cute face, of course! Add some short vertical lines with a fine point pen to give the inner petals texture.
- 6. Finish with a pair of leaves and a cute little pot decorated with a doodle element. I drew a chubby star.














- Draw an upside-down U shape with a slight indent at the top.
- 2. Add 2 "arms" to the U shape, followed by 2 "legs."
- 3. Draw 3 lines to define the "legs."
- 4. At the top, where these lines connect, draw 4 lines (the filaments) in different directions with circles (the anthers) on the ends.



5. Draw a cute face, of course!




6. Draw a smaller cherry blossom off the right "leg" so that it sits a little bit behind this leg. Draw 5 lines within the smaller cherry blossom to define the petals.



7. Add 5 filaments and anthers to the smaller cherry blossom, and leaves to both flowers.


## Volcano













- 1. Draw a short, wavy line with lines that curve out off the sides.
- 2. Complete the crater with a line of dripping lava.
- Continue the curving lines on both sides for a wide mountain shape, then close it up with a straight line that has pointy yet rounded edges.
- 4. With a fine point pen, draw 2 short concave lines coming out of the crater.



5. Continuing with the fine point pen, draw a mushroom cloud.



6. Add detail to the cloud, along with spewing lava off the sides.





## Bamboo






- 1. Draw a very narrow rectangle, making the lines bumpy.
- 2. Draw a longer straight line down the right side and a line half the length of that one on the left side. Complete the bottom of the bamboo segment with a rectangle like you drew in step 1.
- 3. Add lots of little leaves, filling in the open space on the left side.




4. Draw another complete segment with a grouping of leaves on the bottom left, followed by a segment that is incomplete and only a quarter of the length of the other two.




5. Draw an upsidedown trapezoid for the planter, making rounded corners.







6. Add oval rocks of varying sizes to the planter.



7. Extend the bottom bamboo segment into the rocks and add a little bamboo shoot on the right.



8. Add even more little bamboo shoots to the planter.




9. Draw a cute face, of course! With a fine point pen, draw dots and dashes on the large shoot and rocks for texture.

## Great Barrier Reef

This drawing is simpler than it looks! Don't worry about following my drawing exactly and have fun drawing your own Great Barrier Reef.



 Draw a rock shape with some coral coming off it. Don't be afraid to get a little wild when drawing coral!




Keep adding rocks and coral to your scene, building it up and to the sides.




3. Add sea anemone.



Why not add some plants and kelp to the scene? Draw the kelp so it looks to be waving in the water.



5. Continue adding to the scene with some sponges of varying heights.




6. Fill in some open background space with more kelp.








7. At this point, I decided to add some doodle elements, such as chubby stars. Have fun with your underwater scene!



8. With a fine point pen, add more underwater plants with delicate leaves.



Continuing with the fine point pen, draw small ovals, dots, and dashes to give your rocks texture. Draw cute faces, of course!




10. Finish with some fish and bubbles.


4. On the left face of the pyramid, draw equally spaced horizontal lines.




 Continue drawing horizontal lines on the pyramid's right face, lining them up with those on the left face.

7. To replicate bricks, add vertical lines within the horizontal lines. See how the placement of these lines alternates on the left and right faces?















- 1. Draw a wide upside-down V shape with a rounded point.
- Connect the sides of the V shape, making rounded corners. Also draw a short, curved line at the top point of the triangle.
- Draw straight lines from the sides of the triangle and connect the sides, making rounded corners.







5. Draw 2 doors with doorknobs.



Draw parallel lines that run diagonally from the roof to the ground.



7. Repeat step 6 but with the parallel lines running in the opposite direction.























- 1. Draw a triangle, making rounded corners, then draw a 3-sided trapezoid underneath, also with rounded corners. (Draw the triangle in pencil, as you will need to erase lines in a later step. You can ink it then.)
- With a fine point pen, draw an X shape at a slight angle, making sure the center of the X falls in the center of the roof.
- 3. Continuing with the fine point pen, add parallel lines to the 4 lines of the X shape and connect each one with a rounded edge.
- 4. Keep using the fine point pen and make a cross shape with the center being where the lines in step 3 meet.








Erase the pencil lines within the blades. Make sure to look closely at my drawing while you do this.



7. With a fine point pen, make a grid pattern on the 4 blades.



8. Add some windows and a cute face, of course!

## Rondavel











- 1. Draw an incomplete triangle with rounded corners.
- 2. Draw a smaller triangle for the point with a tiny circle on top.
- 3. Draw 2 straight lines from the roof, a little in from the edges. Connect these lines with an incomplete line, making rounded corners.








- 4. Draw an outer line for the base that curves around the house.
- 5. Draw a line below this one that runs parallel to it, for the foundation.
- 6. Add a window and an arched doorway to the house.








8. Finish with some plants and a cute face, of course!

#### Eiffel Tower

Though I get detailed in this doodle, feel free to make your Eiffel Tower as simple or detailed as you want. Look closely at my drawings to capture all the details!











- There are 3 sections to the Eiffel Tower, so draw the in-between structures first, which are rectangles of varying sizes, going from smaller at the top to wider at the bottom.
- Draw the outline of the latticework; at the top, it is narrow and together, splaying out wider toward the base. Also add more details to the structures in between and add lines to the base.

 Start the latticework by drawing horizontal lines down the entire structure.



4. Between the horizontal lines, draw X shapes to fit the spaces. Once you have finished doing this, draw vertical lines down the centers of the Xs, but only in the bottom 2 segments, not the top segment.





Add more details to the bottom in-between structure. Make sure to look closely at my drawing. Draw a cute face, of course!


### Thatched-Roof Cottage












- Draw a roof that is very rounded at the edges, to give the feel that it is made of straw, leaving the side incomplete. Don't forget the chimney!
- 2. Close up the side by drawing a line with 2 notches in it.
- 3. Draw 4 vertical lines for the outline of the cottage. Also add lines to the right sides of the roof notches.



 Add a little addition with a roof off the back of the cottage. Draw a horizontal line from front to back for the cottage's base.




5. Draw windows of varying sizes and shapes, and a door with a small awning and a step. Don't forget to add windows in the roof notches!




6. Add panes to all the windows and a doorknob to the door. With a fine point pen, add some lines to the roof for texture. Decorate the outside of your cozy cottage with bushes, if you like. And draw a cute face, of course!







- Draw a rectangle with the bottom line extending farther out than the sides.
- 2. Using a pencil, draw 3 guidelines, with 2 of them slanting out from the bottom of the rectangle and the third straight down the center.
- Going pack to using a pen, draw 2 slightly slanted lines on either side of the center pencil line.



4. Draw equally spaced horizontal lines between the inner and outer slanted lines, finishing with a long base line.




5. Add vertical lines between the edges of the horizontal lines, like steps.











7. Draw 2 slanted lines from the bottom of the top rectangle to the base of the structure. Add a 3-sided rectangle on top of the top rectangle.









# Taj Mahal


Though I get detailed in this doodle, feel free to make your Taj Mahal as simple or detailed as you want. Look closely at my drawings to capture all the details!




 Draw 3 vertical, connecting rectangles, with the middle one taller and wider than the matching pair on the sides.




 Add another rectangle to each side rectangle, the same size and shape, but draw these so they look like they're bending, kind of like a folding screen.



Draw 8 guldastas, or decorative spires, on top of the edges of the rectangles.




4. Draw a large onion dome, with a finial on top, off the 2 center guldastas. Also add a structure on each side of the onion dome. Make sure to look closely at my drawing!




5. Top the structures added in the previous step with smaller onion domes and finials.




6. Start adding carved details in rectangular shapes to the façade of your Taj Mahal and to the top and bottom of the large onion dome. The smaller onion domes top a columned area (this columned structure with a dome on top is called a *chattri*).




7. Add arches to the rectangular details you drew in the previous step.










- Draw an X shape in the oval, with tiny semicircles where the lines meet the paper lantern. Add a flame—the heat makes the lantern float!







1. Draw a shape, kind of like a squatter version of a bowling pin.






3. Add a cute knotted tie, like a scarf knotted under a chin.



4. Draw 2 lines curving off the knotted tie to the sides of the doll, for the shawl.


