**Level 1:** Beginning to read

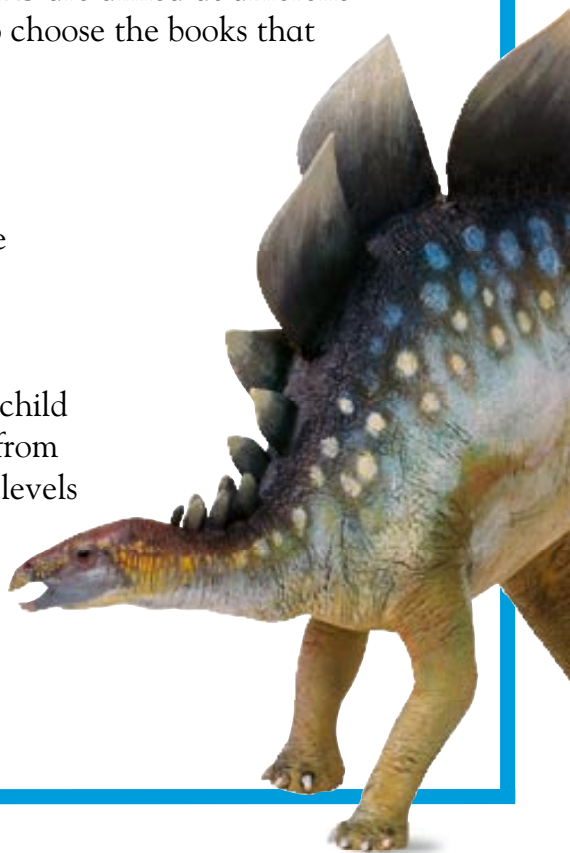
**Level 2:** Beginning to read alone



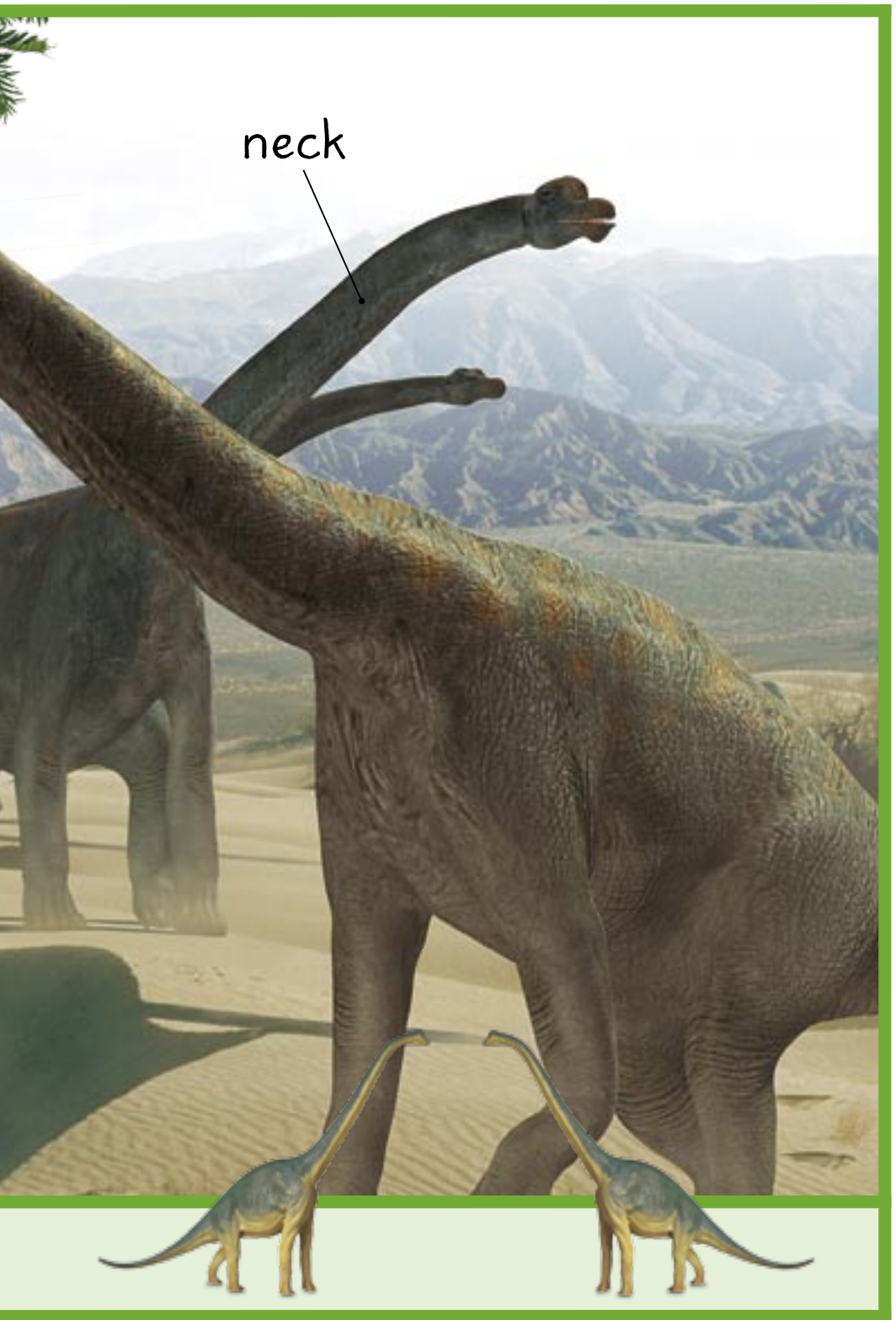

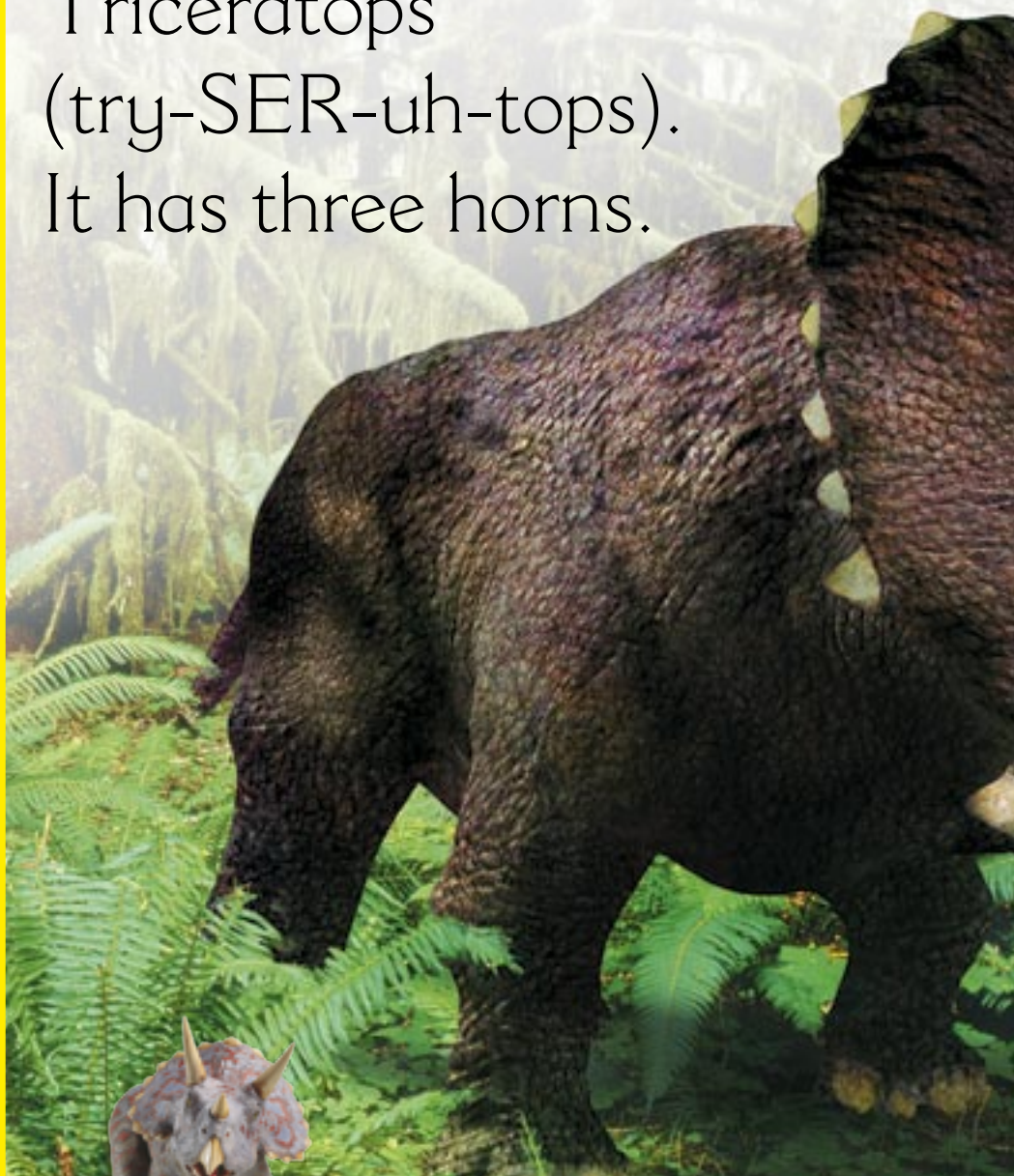

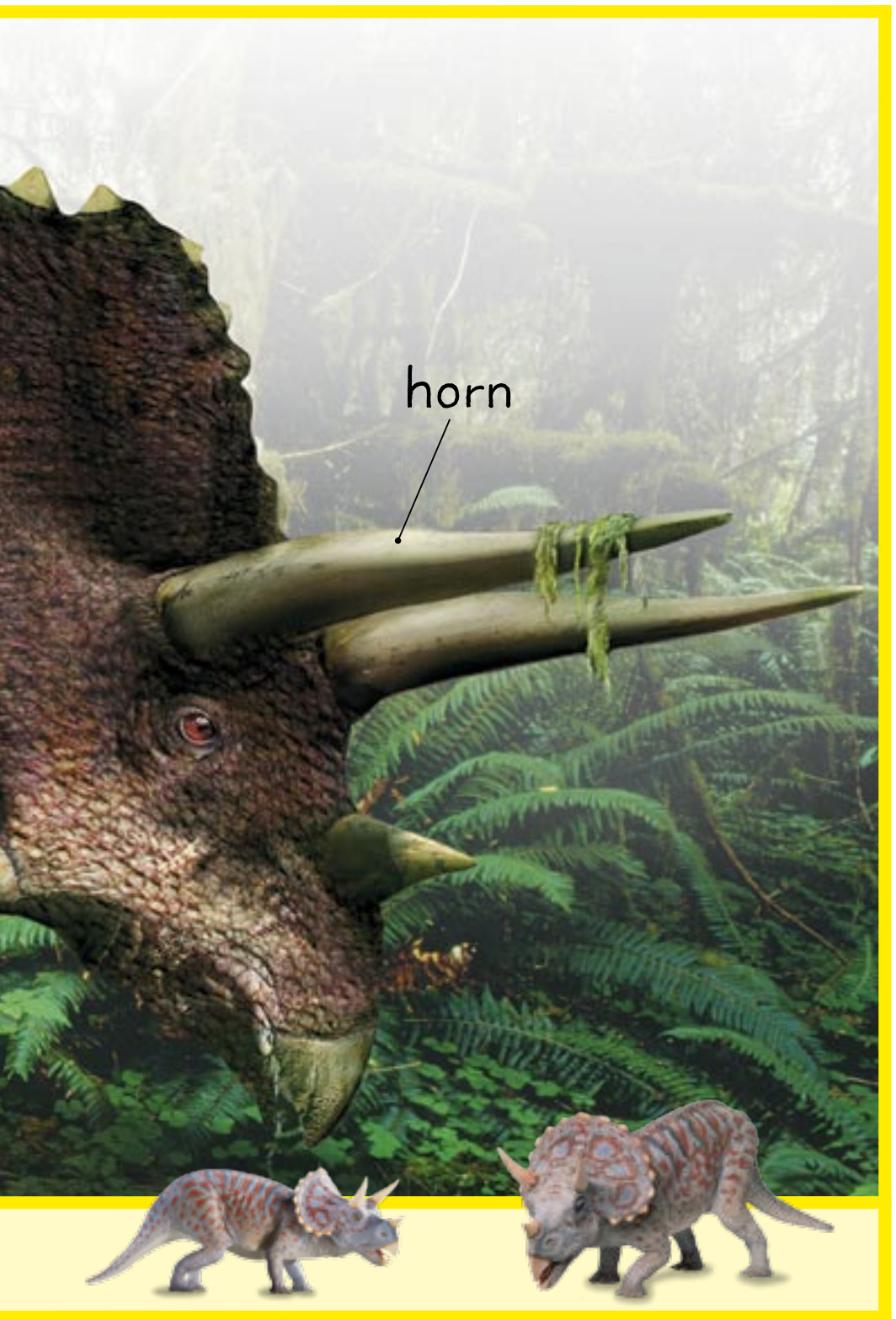

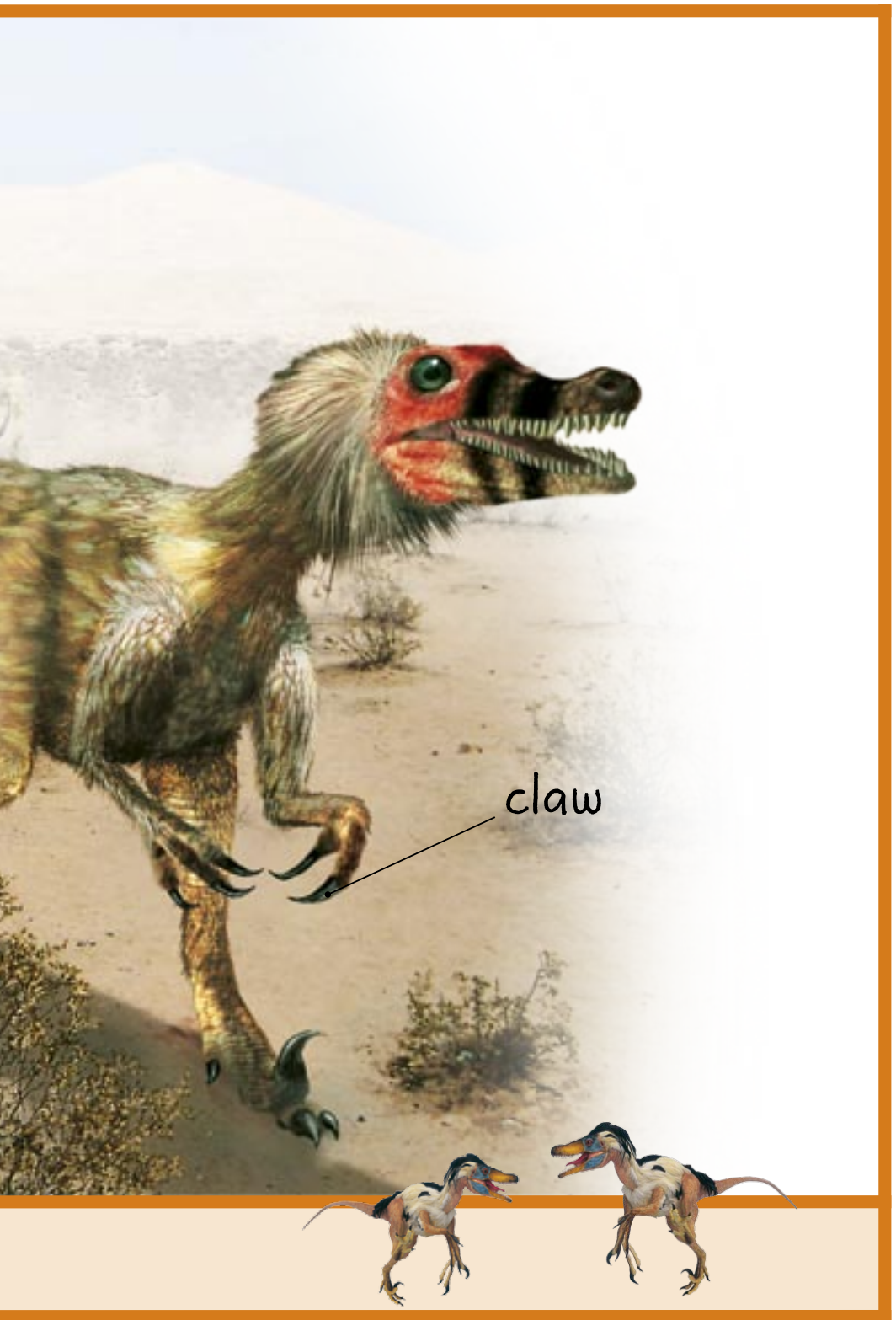

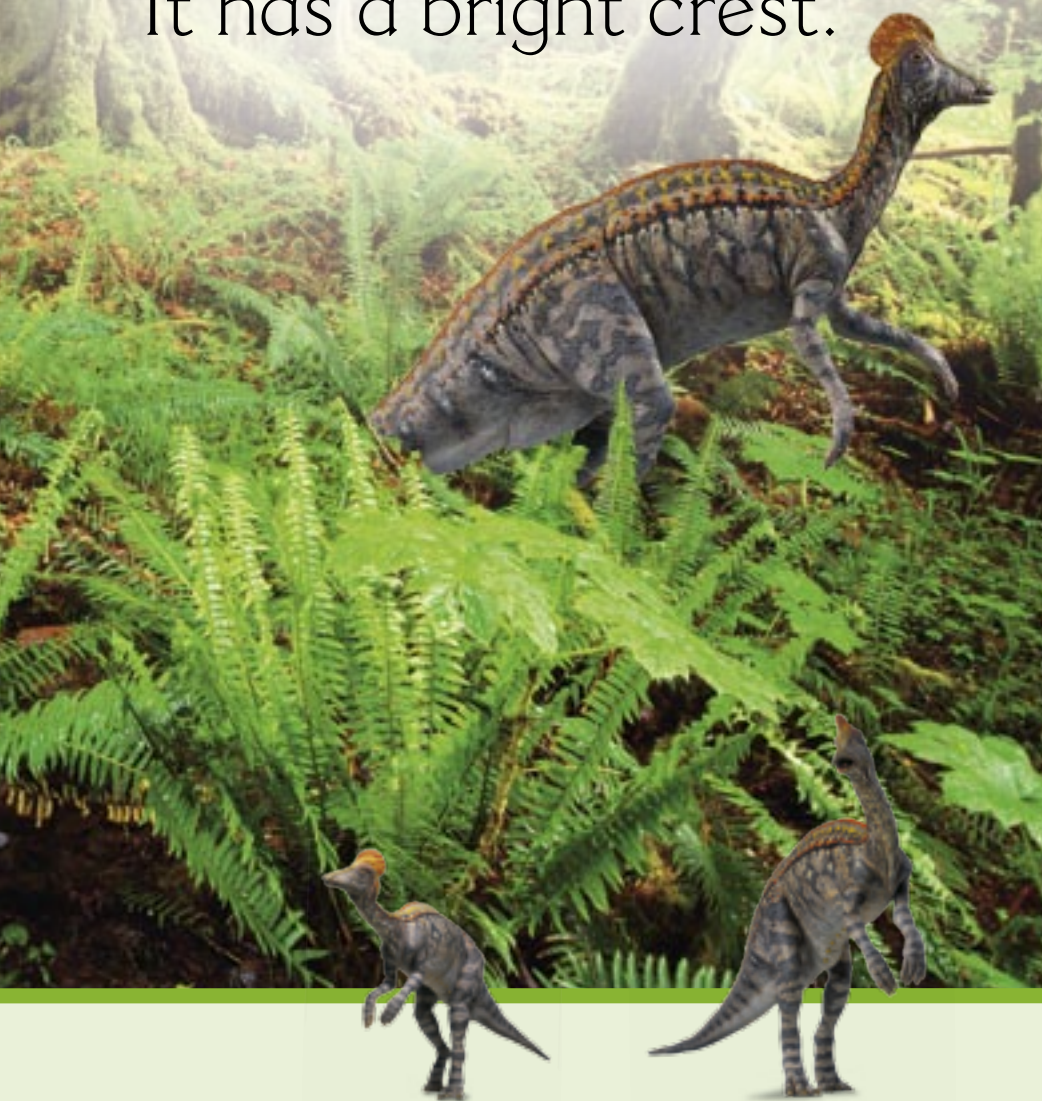

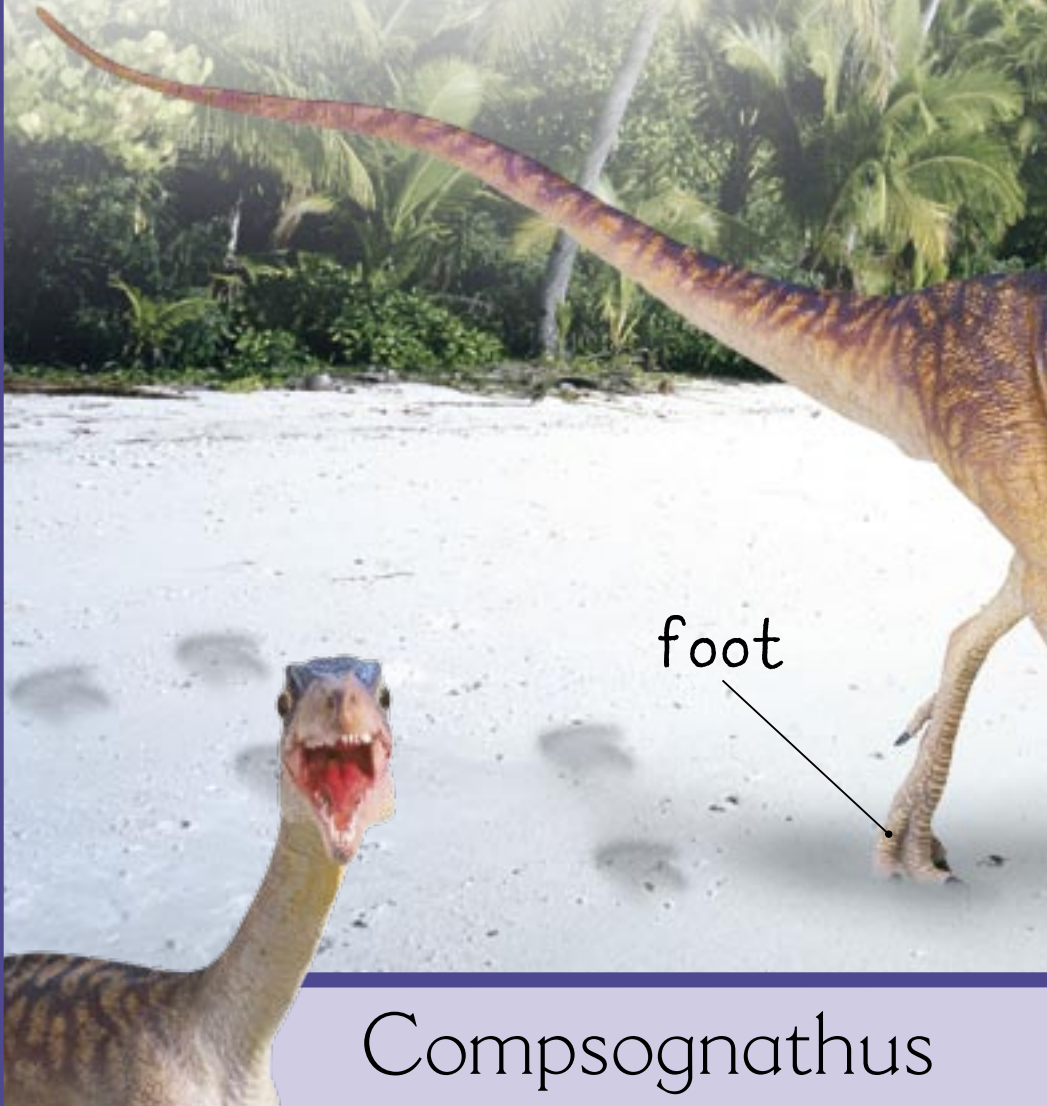

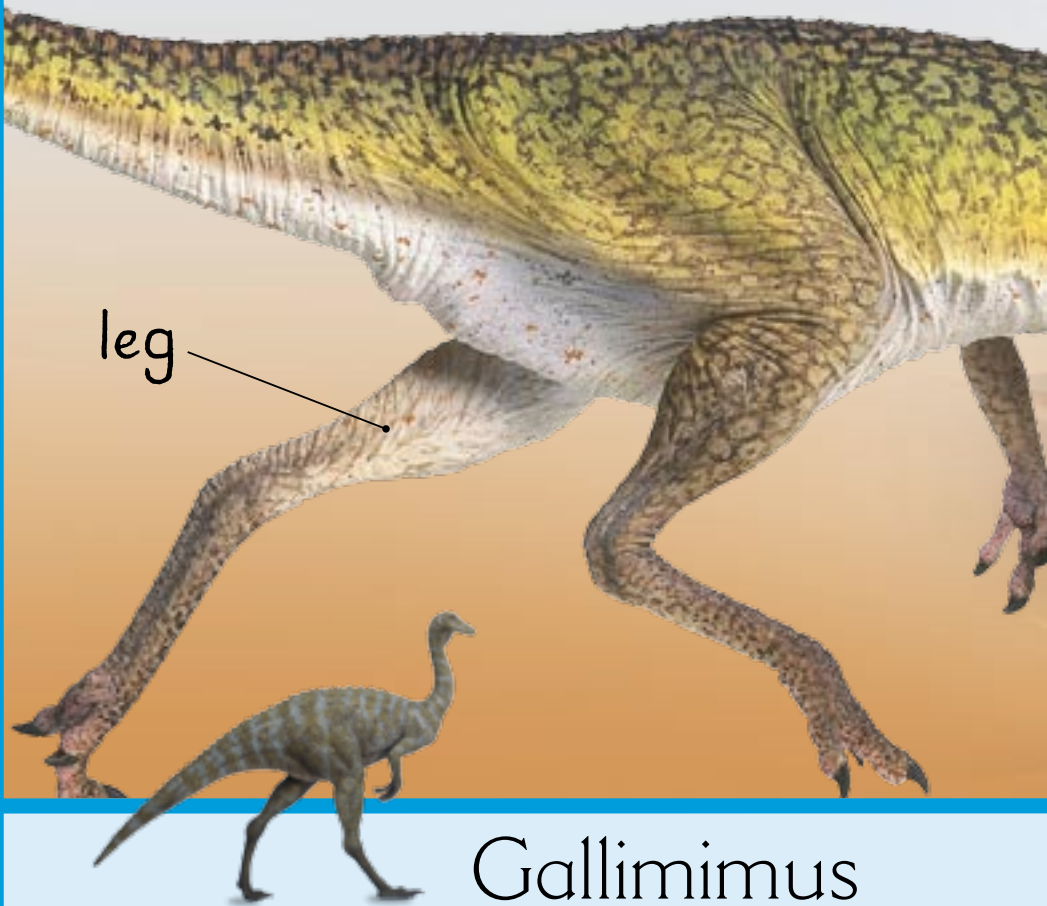
